This information that was provided by parents was used by Ofsted as part of their evidence of how well the school is doing. As with all inspections (and it wasn't that long ago the school has its Church School inspection), the inspectors are rigorous and spend time in lessons, with staff and talking with children to make their judgements. Thank you to those parents who spoke with the inspectors in the playground too. They were very appreciative of the time you gave them in helping to build up a picture of what it is like at St Johns. In terms of the next steps, we will receive a draft copy of the report, which can take three weeks to arrive. We are then able to check this for factual accuracy before it is then published on the Ofsted website and on our school website. We will send out copies of the report as soon as they are available. 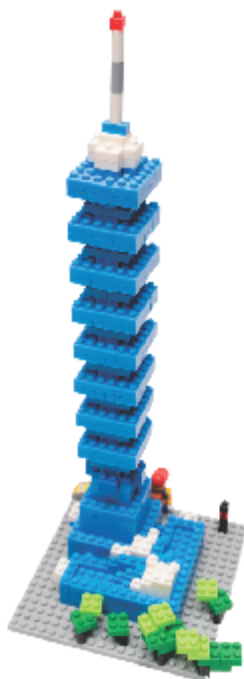

Unlocking Autism for Parents

**Assisting parental understanding of autism,
communication and sensory needs.**

Who is it for?

- Unlocking Autism is a free course for parents and carers of children and young people with communication and interaction needs. You must live in North Yorkshire or your child attend a North Yorkshire school or setting to be eligible. Children do not need to have a diagnosis of autism in order for parents to attend.

What will I learn?

- The programme includes sessions on behaviour, emotional regulation, Communication, sensory differences and autism providing practical tools and strategies to support children and young people.

When does the course take place?

- This is an online course which consists of five sessions which either run over two full days or as five, 2 hour webinars. It is recommended that parents/carers complete all five sessions in order to derive maximum benefit from the programme.

How do I book?

- You will need to register on the website first, and make sure you put **parent** in the job title/organisation boxes and 'attend training course' in reason section. Please follow the instructions in this leaflet. Then you're all set up to go and book on to whichever course suits you best.

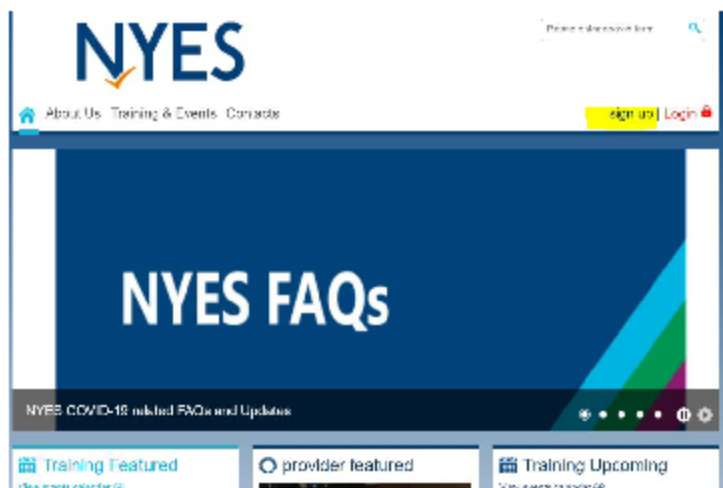

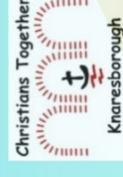
