## 28/29 September 2019

Knareborough Forest : past present and future – kick starting the Yorkshire White Rose Forest – tree planting to absorb carbon, water retention, food production, wildlife habitat, and improve wellbeing e.g. 'forest bathing', Forest skills and Archery.

New trails and walks – a walking festival throughout the weekend linking Sustrans Greenway with Woodland Trust Nidd Gorge and Conyngham Hall

reducing our carbon footprint – focus on sharing, eg transport, local food, goods, energy etc.

A 'transition' for Knareborough: displays and demonstrations rethinking many things such as transport, accessibility (including a cliff lift), minimising waste etc
